I've been developing communities for 35 years and this is the craziest home sales market I have ever seen! Existing homes are selling in a day....often receiving 10 plus offers, many over list price. And the most outrageous thing I've heard, is an offer made with the price left blank, and the seller told to just fill it in!!! What's the explanation....it's a combination of folks leaving the large, northeast cities and west coast looking for a better way of life (and finding it in the mid-Atlantic region), historically low mortgage interest rates, and a lack of inventory as many people opted to delay putting their home on the market for fear that a potential purchaser may bring COVID into the home.

And it's not just resales that are hot, as we sold 69 new homes in the first quarter of this year, our best quarter ever!! In years past, if we sold 8-10 custom homes a year, we were thrilled. We've sold 17 custom homes in Banyan Cove already, and I would not be surprised if we sold out the entire neighborhood by the end of this year.

From a development standpoint, the weather has finally improved, and we're making great progress on all of our projects, including; *Glen Abbey*, our next neighborhood of 55' product by Craftmaster Homes and HHHunt Homes, with completion projected for mid May, *Palisades Cove*, our next townhome neighborhood, *Charleston Club – Phase 3*, which includes a bridge across Blackman Creek, and the final phases of Woolridge road and Magnolia Green Parkway, which will complete our internal loop.

Construction of *Magnolia Academy Children's Center* continues to progress with the building starting to take shape, and a scheduled opening for later this year. Work at *Moseley Elementary School* also continues with opening targeted for the 2022/2023 school year.

With the Governor's easing of COVID restrictions starting April 1st, including allowing 50 persons at inside, social gatherings, we are opening the Charleston Club amenity on Friday, April 30th. The amenity is for the use of the property owners in Charleston Village, Charleston Club, and other like neighborhoods. The Aquatic Center and Arbor Walk pools will open this year per our normal schedule, which is 10 am on the Saturday morning of Memorial Day weekend.

As many of you already know, we made the decision a few weeks ago to put the welcome center and the adjacent 6 acre parcel up for sale. We finally have enough roof tops in and around Magnolia Green that we are seeing interest in our commercial properties, and we feel the time is right to sell what we believe are two of the most valuable parcels in the project. I can't tell you what will end up there, but I can assure everyone we will only consider offers that propose uses that are a complement to, and value-add, to the wonderful community we have spent 12 years developing. If the 6 acre parcel happens to sell, our plans are to move the farmers market to one of our commercial parcels located approximately half a mile west, on Hull Street road. The HOA office is moving to the office at the Aquatic Center, and our marketing team will operate out of the development office located on Otterdale road, just south of the community entrance.

As always, thank you for choosing to make Magnolia Green your home.

HOA UPDATE

The 2021 pool season for both the Arbor Walk pool and Aquatic Center pools officially starts at 10 am on Saturday, May 29th of Memorial Day weekend. Please drop your ID's in the drop box now located outside the office entry at the Aquatic Center (the HOA office previously located at the Welcome Center has moved to the office at the Aquatic Center). The HOA staff will verify you are current with your assessments and if so, will add the 2021 sticker and return the ID's to your mailbox. If a replacement ID is needed, the fee is \$25 per ID being replaced. Please do not wait until the last minute to obtain your photo IDs.


