### From the desk of Tom Page...

Construction of our new elementary school, *Moseley Elementary*, is now complete. For those of you who were unable to attend the ribbon-cutting ceremony and tour of the facility, the school is quite impressive. A beautiful, "super-sized" gymnasium that opens up to the cafeteria via a retractable wall provides seating space for several thousand folks looking to enjoy a play, musical performance, or awards ceremony on the school's stage. From an educational standpoint, the school offers a "STEAM" program with classrooms dedicated to Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math and all of the school's classrooms feature "smart boards" that enhance the ability of the teachers to communicate ideas or concepts to the kids. According to principal Karen Dubiel, all of the required teachers have been hired and are busy readying the classrooms for the start of school on August 22nd! From a new home sales standpoint, we continue to see a reduced amount of traffic visiting the project and our model homes, but sales remain fairly strong with 106 homes sold year-to-date. Our goal for the year is 190, and we still feel confident we will meet or exceed this goal.

Our lot inventory continues to improve as *Glen Abbey – Phase 2*, which includes 36 lots and homes by CraftMaster and HHHunt, is now complete and we are well underway with the development of *Meridian Phase 1*, a total of 55 lots and a continuation of Ryan Home's *Hampton Pointe* product line, *Palisades Cove – Phase 2*, 59 more lots of Hunt's townhome product, and *Legacy Park – Phase 2*, which includes sixty-seven lots and homes by CraftMaster and Lifestyle.

The latest updates on our park and civic sites are as follows. Recent conversations with county officials indicate funding for our future 28-acre county park will not be included in the bond offering that will be voted on by county residents in the coming weeks. This means funding for the park, which is located adjacent to the new elementary school, will probably be delayed at least another 2 years. As far as the 10-acre civic site is concerned, officials said a likely use for the site is a regional police station, but a final decision on the matter had not been made. The civic site is located on the east side of Magnolia Green Parkway, just north of Hull street road.

Interest in our commercial parcels remains limited, but we expect activity to increase as both Magnolia Green, and the surrounding area, continues to grow. Finally, please join me in welcoming Mike West to the management team at the golf club. Mike is the new general manager and will oversee all operations at the club. ### Fall is just around the corner...

Fall is the ideal time to groom your lawn. The cool fall weather will help grassroots to grow and develop paying big dividends next year. Here are some tips for a plush lawn.

- · Continue maintaining your lawn at its normal height until the grass stops growing.
- Water when needed. If mother nature isn't supplying the lawn with at least one inch or more per week, be sure to water.
- Rake the leaves when they fall on the lawn to prevent damage from lack of sunlight or soggy conditions that lead to lawn fungi.
- · Aerate and seed your lawn. Aeration is the process of removing soil plugs from your yard to create passageways for nutrients to reach the grassroots. Seeding your lawn will help to fill in any bare spots and thicken your lawn.
- Fertilize your lawn with a nitrogen-rich fertilizer. This will provide your lawn with the nutrients it needs to get through the winter and be stronger in the spring. Fall is the most important time to fertilize.
- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$  Keep up with lawn pests such as grubs and armyworms.
- · If you need any help, reach out to a professional lawn maintenance contractor to ensure you are on the right track.

Fall is also a fabulous time to complete some exterior home maintenance and repairs. Take a walk around your home, enjoy the fair-weather and check for needed repairs such as missing or loose shingles, damaged siding or loose trim, etc. Check to see if the mailbox has faded, shutters and doors have faded, gutters need to be cleaned, home or driveway/walkways need to be power washed. These honey-do list items are some of the easiest things to do to keep your home looking it's best.

Spending time outdoors and with neighbors is one of the perks of living in our community. Please be reminded that grills and fire pits must be placed and used behind the home. Please be sure that your assessments are paid to date as access to the amenities may be restricted for past due accounts.

Please be reminded that trash dumpsters located at Arbor Walk, the Aquatic Center, the Tennis Center, and Charleston Club are not for disposing of any homeowner debris or trash. These are strictly for trash generated at each facility.

If you see something, say something! Please remember that the Chesterfield Non-Emergency Police phone number is **804-748-1251.** We encourage all homeowners that see any suspicious activity to call this number immediately, followed by a call or email to the HOA.

### Property Improvements/ Modifications

In Magnolia Green, all improvements or modifications to the exterior of the home, or the lot/landscape, require approval by the Architectural Review Committee ("ARC"). The HOA has contracted with an independent, licensed architectural firm to function as the ARC, whose responsibility is to ensure the proposed improvements are in conformance with the design standards adopted for that particular neighborhood. The design standards for your neighborhood can be found at gmgva.com, under documents. Fees are charged for the review/approval process and they will vary depending upon the type of modification requested.

Please note that any exterior modification to the home or lot must be approved in writing by the ARC prior to starting any work. Work started or completed prior to approval by the ARC is subject to removal if after plans have been submitted and reviewed by the ARC, any addition or improvement is deemed to be not in compliance with the standards.

To submit an application for any property improvement, please go to www.gmgva.com, log in to your account, click on ACC Request and provide the required documentation. Please email or call the on-site team for any assistance in this process.





### RED BALL - AGES 8 & UNDER

Lower compression ball & smaller court (36 foot) allows players to rally and enjoy the game without being overwhelmed by high bouncing balls and a larger court.

Shorter & lighter racquets are also used (21'-23').

### Tiny Tots (ages 5&6) - Sunday, 10:00-10:30am Red Ball I (ages 7&8) - Sunday, 10:30-11:30am


