#### From the desk of Tom Page...

As many of you know, there is concern among some analysts that our economy is heading for a recession, and these concerns have been fueled recently by the significant number of layoffs announced by several of the leading tech firms. While these layoffs are concerning, locally, we continue to see new job creation, highlighted by the following:

- The new *LEGO* plant being built in *Meadowville Technology Park*, which is bringing 1,760 new jobs to our area
- The new office tower being constructed downtown by *CoStar*; which has advertised it will be hiring 2,000 new employees at the facility

New jobs mean more folks relocating to our area, which means more new home sales. And while the influx of folks moving to our area from other states in the northeast has subsided since its peak in the COVID years, it has been offset by the significant increase in families moving to our area from northern Virginia. Prior to 2022, the average number of No.VA relos was 7,000 per year. In 2022, that number jumped to approximately 13,000. These folks are seeking relief from extremely expensive housing, and major congestion, and are finding the answer in the southwest Richmond area, which bodes well for Magnolia Green.

From a new home sales standpoint, traffic remains fairly normal for this time of year, and we continue to sell homes in all of our various product offerings, albeit at a slower pace. The good news is home values have not been significantly impacted, due primarily to the lack of new home inventory in the marketplace. In addition, the costs that impact new home construction appear to be stabilizing, and in many cases, with lumber being the prime example, decreasing significantly, and mortgage rates appear to have peaked and have dropped slightly over the last several weeks to just over 6%. Lower home prices resulting from lower costs, combined with lower mortgage rates, should result in improved home sales over the remaining months of 2023.

With our prime, spring selling season just around the corner, our lot inventory is strong and will improve drastically over the next few months. *Meridian Phase 1*, a total of 55 lots and a continuation of Ryan Home's *Hampton Pointe* product line, and *Palisades Cove – Phase 2*, 59 more lots of HHHunt's townhome product, are both complete and actively selling homes. *Legacy Park – Phase 2*, which includes sixty-seven lots and homes by CraftMaster and Lifestyle, will be complete sometime in March and the development of *Eagle Bend*, offering 43 eighty-foot-wide lots with homes by Schell Brothers, has commenced. And lastly, *Turtle Pointe*, our final custom-home neighborhood with only 25 lots, some of which front golf hole number 5, will be starting shortly.

Our marketing efforts on the welcome center building/site, and the adjacent 6-acre commercial parcel continue, but we do not have any developments to report currently. Finally, we are working with the golf club management team on reviving the outdoor concerts we once hosted on the driving range. Our first concert will be on Saturday, July 1st, with The Deloreans providing the musical entertainment. We are also lining up our vendors for the 2023 Farmer's Market, which opens May 6th.

The HOA has contracted with an independent, licensed architectural firm to function as the ARC, whose responsibility is to ensure the proposed improvements are in conformance with the design standards adopted for that particular neighborhood. The design standards for your neighborhood can be found at gmgva.com, under documents. Fees are charged for the review/approval process and they will vary depending upon the type of modification requested.

Please note that any exterior modification to the home or lot must be approved in writing by the ARC prior to starting any work. Work started or completed prior to approval by the ARC is subject to removal if after plans have been submitted and reviewed by the ARC, any addition or improvement is deemed to be not in compliance with the standards.

A community-wide email was recently sent to provide updated information and instructions on how to submit an application for your home and property improvements. If you have not signed up for email alerts, please do so at your earliest convenience.




