

#### From the desk of Tom Page...

As we head into the backstretch of 2023, it's hard to believe we are just a few years away from completing the development of Magnolia Green. What was once a failed project in 2009 with 23 homes, partially completed roads, and nine holes of golf operating out of a double-wide mobile trailer, is now one of the most successful, master-planned communities ever developed in this region. The key to Magnolia Green's success is not a secret....it's simply creating a community with high standards for both development and home construction, with a wide variety of product offerings, world-class amenities, and an array of social programming that brings folks together. It's been an incredible journey, something my team is very proud of, and we look forward to finishing this wonderful project.

From a new home sales standpoint, despite mortgage rates having pushed above 7%, we continue to see steady traffic and sales. We've sold 30 homes since the first of June, bringing our yearly total to 103. Leading the way is **Palisades Cove** with 37, followed by 22 sales in **Meridian**, 15 in **Charleston Club**, and 13 in **Legacy Park**.

Our lot development team has been quite busy this summer. We finished up **Palisades**Cove Phase 2 and Legacy Park Phase 2, and are nearing the completion of Eagle Bend, a
neighborhood of 43 eighty-foot wide lots with homes by Schell Brothers. We also just started
Phase 3 of **Palisades Cove**, which includes 76 lots, and will be our last townhome neighborhood
in Magnolia Green. This leaves us with only four neighborhoods of lots to develop to finish out
the project.

The Cardinal Weddings and Events Venue, located in the former welcome center building, is making great progress with their planned site and building improvements and anticipates formally opening for business late September or early October. Andrea Maradiaga, the on-site manager, says their first community event is scheduled for Friday, September 22nd and will feature music by GeekRVA, along with food trucks and activities for the kids.

Our farmer's market, located next to **The Cardinal**, will be hosting its annual Young Entrepreneur Day on Saturday, September 23rd. On this day, kids of all ages will be selling items they have personally created. Please come out and support the kids, along with all our regular vendors.

I'd like to give a shout out to Leighann Albaugh, Director of Instruction at Magnolia Green Golf Club. Leighann was recognized by *GOLF.com* as one of the Golf Top 100 Teachers to Watch list. She has done an amazing job building a junior golf program at the club and has also developed a variety of programs and activities designed to increase the number of women playing golf at the club.

#### **Reminders:**

The holidays are just around the corner, be sure to review the community rules regarding decorations and lighting, and please be courteous of your neighbors.

"Holiday/Seasonal Decoration" as used herein means those temporary decorations and lighting associated with a particular national, state, local or religious holiday. Holiday/Seasonal Decorations may be displayed without ARC approval for up to seven (7) days before and seven (7) days after such holiday, except Christmas and Hanukkah decorations which may be displayed from Thanksgiving through January 7th of each year. Owners desiring to display Holiday/Seasonal Decorations for longer periods should apply to the ARB for permission. Owners are urged to take care and exhibit consideration for their neighbors when displaying Holiday/Seasonal Decorations so as not to cause an unreasonable source of annoyance to occupants of neighboring property. Excessive inflatable displays are prohibited.

Please remember that trash dumpsters located at Arbor Walk, the Aquatic Center, the Tennis Center, and Charleston Club are not for disposing of any homeowner debris or trash. These are strictly for trash generated at each facility.

If you see something, say something! Please remember that the Chesterfield Non-Emergency Police phone number is 804-748-1251. We encourage all homeowners that see any suspicious activity to call this number immediately, followed by a call or email to the HOA.

### Property Improvements/ Modifications

In Magnolia Green, all improvements or modifications to the exterior of the home, or the lot/landscape, require approval by the Architectural Review Committee ("ARC"). The HOA has contracted with an independent, licensed architectural firm to function as the ARC, whose responsibility is to ensure the proposed improvements are in conformance with the design standards adopted for that particular neighborhood. The design standards for your neighborhood can be found at gmgva.com, under documents. Fees are charged for the review/approval process and they will vary depending upon the type of modification requested.

Please note that any exterior modification to the home or lot must be approved in writing by the ARC prior to starting any work. Work started or completed prior to approval by the ARC is subject to removal if after plans have been submitted and reviewed by the ARC, any addition or improvement is deemed to be not in compliance with the standards.

To request approval for an improvement or modification, please log on to **www.gmgva.com**, go to "Homeowner Login and Payments" and then hit the "ACC Request" tab at the top to start the process.




