

From the desk of Tom Page...

I'm very excited to announce we are working with the Chesterfield County Economic Development Authority ("EDA") on a project which will restore and enhance large portions of the two streams that meander south to north through Magnolia Green. Years ago, iStar's environmental engineers prepared plans for the restoration of the two streams, and shortly thereafter, we completed the actual work on a 2,000 l.f. segment of one of the streams. We did so in order to secure "stream credits" to offset future stream impacts from roadway crossings within several of our neighborhoods. We never completed the remaining restoration work included in the plans, because over time, it became more cost effective to simply buy the credits from local "banks". The EDA needs stream credits for all the work occurring just north of Magnolia Green, including the new schools, the roads serving the schools, and their commercial project, and as a result, they are proposing to acquire our stream plans and complete the restoration work. The work improves the streams by reducing erosion, which helps protect properties and infrastructure, improves water quality by reducing contaminants and sediment load, and expands habitats for fish and aquatic wildlife. We'll be scheduling a community meeting in the next week or so to answer questions and provide additional information regarding this exciting project.

From a new home sales standpoint, now that we're past the summer vacation/travel season, sales have picked up, bringing us to 69 homes sold year-to-date. Continuing to lead the way is *HHHunt's Palisades Cove* with 27, followed by 12 sales in the recently released Schell Brother's Barrington neighborhood, 12 sales in Legacy Park 2 (Lifestyle Homes and Mungo Homes), and 8 sales in Schell Brother's Eagle Bend!

Our lot development team recently completed the development of the 25 lots in *Barrington* (formerly called *Turtle Pointe*), our last section of ninety-foot-wide lots, meaning *Schell Brothers* is free to start construction of the sold homes. The team is also developing the 52 lots in *Charleston Landing*, an age-targeted neighborhood whose homes will be built by *Mungo Homes*, along with the 41 lots in *Meridian 2*, with homes by *Ryan Homes*.

The plans for the 78 lots in *Hammock Creek 2*, along with the plans for a new bridge over *Blackman Creek*, are finally approved, however, we continue to work with the county on the scope of improvements required for Duval Road. We hope to have this finalized soon so that we can start development of the lots, and construction of the bridge, before the end of the year. The product will be a continuation of the homes currently offered by *Mongo Homes* and *HHHunt Homes* in Section 1.

Finally, a shout-out to *Kim Hintos* and all the folks who assist with organizing, and managing our *Sea Dragons* swim team, along with the coaches and swimmers for another great season! I'd also like to thank Tanner Kelson and the team at Coastline Aquatics, for doing a great job managing our pools this year, along with helping when needed with the home swim meets!

As always, thank you for choosing to make Magnolia Green your home!


